

SAFEGUARDING POLICY

PROMOTING A SAFER ENVIRONMENT

The following policy has been agreed by the Steering Group, the Representatives and volunteers of the Four Rivers Dementia Alliance and will need to be reviewed in January 2026.

Four Rivers Dementia Alliance is committed to:

- Promoting a safer environment and culture for the volunteers and all those involved.
- Safely recruiting and supporting all those with any responsibility related to vulnerable adults, younger people and children within the communities it serves.
- Responding promptly to every safeguarding concern or allegation.
- Caring pastorally for victims/survivors of abuse and other affected persons.
- Caring pastorally for those who are the subject of concerns or allegations of abuse and other affected persons.
- Responding to those that may pose a present risk to others.

Four Rivers Dementia Alliance will:

- Create a safe and caring place for all.
- Safely recruit, train and support all those with any responsibility for vulnerable adults, younger people and children to have the confidence and skills to recognise and respond to abuse.
- Ensure that there is appropriate insurance cover for all activities involving people of all ages undertaken by Four Rivers Dementia Alliance.
- Display on the Four Rivers Dementia Alliance website the details of who to contact if there are safeguarding concerns or support needs.
- Listen to and take seriously all those who disclose abuse.
- Take steps to protect anyone affected by dementia when a safeguarding concern of any kind arises, notifying the statutory agencies immediately.
- Offer support to victims/survivors of abuse regardless of the type of abuse, when or where it occurred.
- Monitor and show concern for any member of the community who may pose a risk to people of all ages whilst maintaining appropriate confidentiality and the safety of all parties.
- Ensure that policies, procedures and risk assessments are in place and that these are reviewed bi-annually, especially those linked to recruitment.

Each person who volunteers for Four Rivers Dementia Alliance will have access to this policy via the website and agree to abide the guidelines.
